BOO POCKET GHOST KEYCHAIN

A quick, beginner-friendly amigurumi pattern

EASY

45-60 MINUTES

US TERMS

Finished size: approximately 6.5 cm / 2.5 in, excluding the keyring

Before You Begin

This little ghost is worked in continuous rounds. The body is closed underneath, then a separate scalloped skirt is added to the unused front loops for a soft floating shape.

Materials

- 3.0 mm crochet hook
- DK or light worsted cotton yarn: 15-20 g in white
- Small scraps of black and pink yarn
- Two 8 mm safety eyes, or black yarn for embroidered eyes
- Polyester stuffing
- Tapestry needle, scissors, and stitch marker
- 25 mm split keyring with a short chain

Abbreviations

MR	magic ring
ch	chain
sc	single crochet
hdc	half double crochet
dc	double crochet
inc	2 sc in one stitch
dec	invisible single crochet decrease
sl st	slip stitch
BLO	back loop only
FO	fasten off

GAUGE

Gauge is not critical. Use a hook small enough to create a firm fabric so the stuffing does not show.

SKILL LEVEL

Easy. You should know the magic ring, single crochet, increase, decrease, and working in continuous rounds.

SAFETY NOTE

For gifts intended for babies or children under three, embroider the eyes instead of using safety eyes. Check the keyring attachment regularly.

The Ghost Body

Work in continuous rounds. Do not join unless instructed.

ROUND	INSTRUCTIONS	STITCHES
1	6 sc in MR	6
2	inc in each stitch around	12
3	(1 sc, inc) x 6	18
4	(2 sc, inc) x 6	24
5	(3 sc, inc) x 6	30
6-11	sc in each stitch around	30
12	BLO: sc in each stitch around	30
13	(3 sc, dec) x 6	24
14	(2 sc, dec) x 6	18
15	(1 sc, dec) x 6	12
16	dec x 6, FO and close the opening	6

FACE PLACEMENT

Insert the eyes between Rounds 7 and 8, with 6 visible stitches between them. Embroider a small curved mouth between Rounds 8 and 9. Add two short pink stitches for cheeks if desired.

STUFFING

Begin stuffing after Round 13. Fill the top firmly and the lower body more lightly so the ghost stays rounded without becoming hard or lumpy.

Optional Little Arms

Make 2. Ch 5. Starting in the second chain from the hook, work: sl st, sc, hdc, sc. FO with a long tail. Sew one arm to each side across Rounds 9-10, angling the tips slightly upward.

KEYRING HANGER

With two strands of white yarn held together, ch 10 and join with a sl st to form a loop. Pull both tails through the top center of the ghost and knot them securely inside before the body is closed.

Scalloped Skirt & Finishing

The scallops are worked into the unused front loops from Round 12.

1

Join white yarn to any unused front loop from Round 12.

2

Repeat around: sl st in next loop, 4 dc in next loop, sl st in next loop.

3

You will make 10 scallops. Join with a sl st and FO.

4

Weave in every end. Shape each scallop gently with your fingers.

5

Clip the split ring through the crocheted hanger loop.

6

Check that the hanger, eyes, and all sewn pieces are secure.

Make It Your Own

- Use pale lavender, mint, peach, or grey yarn for a pastel ghost collection.
- Embroider sleepy eyes, a tiny heart mouth, or simple eyelashes.
- Add a small felt bow, but keep embellishments lightweight for a keychain.
- Make several ghosts and use them as zipper pulls, bag charms, or party favors.
